NSW CFMMEU OFFICIALS CHARGED WITH CORRUPTION OFFENCES

Members are advised that the NSW Trade Union Taskforce (a joint agency taskforce comprising members of the AFP and NSW Police) today charged NSW State Secretary Daren Greenfield and Assistant State Secretary Michael Greenfield with corruption offences as part of a long running investigation into allegedly corrupt payments from builders to union office holders.
